UIA RESOLUTION ON INTERVENTIONS IN SIGNIFICANT AND HISTORICAL URBAN PUBLIC SPACES

During its 122nd Session in Beijing, (October 21-22) the UIA Council adopted the following resolution:

UIA Council states that public spaces require non-negotiable quality, public governance and transparency. Therefore it is strongly recommended that all interventions in significant and historical urban public spaces be submitted to public consultation and be the outcome of architectural or town planning Competitions under the UIA UNESCO regulations.
